The Role of the Sea to Sky Family Advisory Committee (FAC) is to represent the diverse voices of families within Sea to Sky Mental Health and Substance Use Services.

The FAC acts in advisory, advocacy, and educational roles to improve the experience of care.

Membership consists of family members and mental health and substance use professionals.

Using a collaborative approach, the FAC strives to positively influence the planning and implementation of mental health and substance use care in the Sea to Sky Corridor.

What We Do

The Sea to Sky FAC meets once a month to discuss how we can improve services for families and consumers, and to learn about developments in services through guest speakers and information-sharing.

There are also opportunities to get involved in working groups that address specific issues (e.g., housing; substance use; etc.).

We work to facilitate the development and maintenance of a culture that supports family involvement, ensure that services reflect best practices of client and family-centered care, and support the ongoing development of a culture of recovery.
